## 5th annual juried competition

The Annual Pierpont Commons Juried Competition provides a unique opportunity for students, faculty, staff and area artists to mount a month long solo exhibit throughout the 2007-2008 academic year.

### awards

This year we are pleased to announce, that the winning artists will receive a \$200 stipend for their exhibit.

### eligibility

Individual 2D, 3D artists, fine craftspeople working in ceramics, metal, glass, paper, fiber, and others are encouraged to apply. Artists must be living or studying within the state of Michigan.

### right of refusal

The images you submit are assumed to be accurate representations of actual work for exhibition. The Pierpont Commons Arts and Programs Office will exercise the right to reject any work not accurately represented or any work that is too fragile, improperly prepared for exhibit, damaged, or over-valued.

### insurance

The Pierpont Commons Arts and Programs Office will provide insurance for work at fair market value while it is in our care. Student work can be insured for material value only.

### exhibit details

The unique location of the Pierpont Commons on North Campus plays host to a variety of cultural and social events for a growing population of students, faculty, staff and visitors. Approximately 6,000 people use the building daily.

The Wall Gallery is 88 linear ft. by 10 ft. high. All framed art must be fitted with picture hanging wire or hardware. Artists must supply their own labels.

Any work larger than the cases must either stand on the floor or on a pedestal. All hanging art and individual pieces may not exceed 100 lbs. All accepted work will remain on exhibit for the duration of the entire exhibition period.

### sales

With the exception of U of M students, The Pierpont Commons charges a 30% commission on sales; commissions help to support the operation of our galleries.

### delivery & installation

Artists are responsible for the delivery, pick-up and installation of all artwork at a scheduled time arranged with our staff. Artwork is generally installed and taken down as close to the first and last day of the month as is possible.
