The Open Studio Process: Exploring three dimensions- with Idelle Hammond Sass,

May 13, 2017, 10 a.m. – 2 p.m., Ann Arbor, MI

This workshop will introduce a three-part process that sparks creativity, encourages artistic play and helps you investigate the creative process. Use this process in your studio work, journal and to break through boundaries, assumptions, and creative blocks. Participants will each work with materials and do some writing, setting an intention for their time in the studio. We will share our work and read aloud from our notes as time allows.

We'll have a wide range of materials to work with, copper, wire, enamels and brass sheet, to plastics, papers, aluminum foil, masking tape, found objects, paint and materials that participants will bring and share, leading to surprising results.

The workshop will take place in a fully functional home studio in Ann Arbor, with torches, a hydraulic press, shears and an enameling kiln. Participants may want to bring their own hand tools, drills, sterling and other precious or non-precious materials (beads, pearls, wire etc) they want to incorporate. Please bring your sketchbook or journal to draw and write in.

Coffee, water, tea and snacks will be provided, but bring a lunch if you wish. If you wish to take a break, there is a deck outside to enjoy, and a sitting area downstairs with a table outside the studio. Registration is limited to 7 participants.
